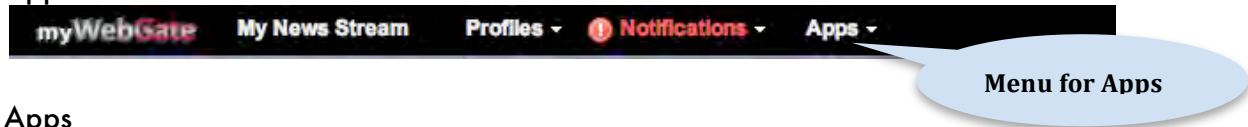


Help 3. Using myLLL Discussion: The Discussion Application

The black MENU bar has tabs to move between My News Stream, Profiles, Notifications and Apps.




Apps
